NEIL ELLIS BOTELLARY PINOTAGE

VITICULTURE

The Ellis family focuses on delivering terroir driven wines from selected in the Western Cape region with their main vineyards located in Stellenbosch, Jonkershoek, and Elgin Valley. Harvesting is done by hand and usually done at night in order to maintain the grapes natural freshness.

VINIFICATION

In the cellar, Warren Ellis practices low intervention techniques. Fermentation takes place in stainless steel and depending on the style of wine, the wine either stays in stainless steel on its fine lees or is transferred to a combination of 500 I new and used French oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES

Just outside Cape Town lies the rolling hills of the Bottelary region, creating a unique terrain for the cultivation of Pinotage; one of the wild horses in grape varieties. This is where sun, slopes and sea breezes combine to produce an elegant, medium bodied and well-structured Pinotage that has been described as one of the best examples of the variety in the world. The Bottelary vineyard is planted with bush vines that are more than 20 years old and that grow on decomposed granite. This multi-faceted wine shows dark plum, cherry and blackberry fruit touched by elegant floral notes. The tannins are ripe, fresh and well-integrated, providing the perfect backbone and structure.

PAIRING SUGGESTION

Great choice with pepper steak, osso buco, venison and game birds, roasted lamb, a traditional bobotie as well as any kind of South African braai.

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
