VITICULTURE

The Jonkershoek Valley, east of Stellenbosch, is a cooler, high-altitude ward with vineyards reaching 300–400 m and receiving over 1,000 mm of annual rainfall. Neil Ellis sources fruit from southwest-facing slopes on well-drained decomposed granite and Table Mountain sandstone soils.

The site's elevation, ocean breezes, and low yields contribute to slow ripening, refined tannin development, and balanced acidity. This unique terroir consistently produces Cabernet Sauvignon of structure, black fruit depth, and hallmark Jonkershoek elegance.
