## **VITICULTURE**

The 2020 Stellenbosch Cabernet Sauvignon is sourced from select vineyard sites across Stellenbosch, with a focus on the Jonkershoek Valley and Bottelary Hills wards. These sites were chosen for their complementary terroirs—Jonkershoek, with its cooler microclimate and elevated slopes, contributes structure, finesse, and freshness, while the warmer Bottelary Hills offer richness, ripe fruit character, and depth.

Vines are planted on well-drained decomposed granite soils, ideal for promoting deep root development and balanced growth. Trellising systems are carefully managed to optimize sun exposure and airflow, while supplementary irrigation is used judiciously to support vine health and ensure consistent ripening. The result is a harmonious, site-driven expression of Stellenbosch Cabernet Sauvignon.
